Dear All,

Thank you for your continued support of the White Rose Maths Hub. We are delighted that you are interested in using our assessments and we really hope they are a success within your school.

We are inviting schools, who are interested, to help us build on the work we have been doing. We would love to hear from any schools that use our assessments and would encourage any feedback you may have.

If you use the assessments we have two projects that you might be interested in.

Project 1: Collecting data

The collection of data from schools that complete the assessments will allow us to compare results and help schools recognise any mathematical areas that may need development.

We would be looking to create a large data set so that schools can compare their performance.

Please let us know whether, as a school, you would find this useful and whether you would be willing to share your results for comparison with other schools.

Project 2: Sharing Lesson Ideas – Free Networking

We have partnered with an organisation called Myflo and are looking at using their free online platform to create a network of teachers who want to share their lesson plans and ideas around our scheme. We are looking to hear from any schools who would like to be part of a trial for this software. There is no cost for being part of this project.

Critical feedback would then allow us to develop this network further. We would ideally look to begin this trial in January 2016.

Project 3: Free CPD

In the New Year, we are going to be holding some free Professional Development events focused around teaching certain mastery topics. It is nearly one year since our “Celebration of Maths” event and we are looking to organise some mini twilight versions. If you have someone in your school that you feel is an exceptional teacher and would love to showcase their work then please let us know.

Project 4: Mixed Year Group and EYFS

As part of the feedback we have received, there are two areas that are continually requested for additional support. The first is schemes for Early Years teaching, the second is schemes to help teachers in mixed year group settings.

We have set up two working parties of primary teachers to develop these schemes and hopefully give some advice on how the schemes can be used. If you feel you have any expertise in this area, then please get in touch. We hope to release some additional guidance as soon as we can.
