What is Young Voices?

We will be singing in a huge concert at the NEC in Birmingham on **THURSDAY 16TH JANUARY 2025** with 6,500 other children. It's an incredible experience and it's like being a rockstar!

How does my child take part?

Join the club! 3.15-4.15pm every **Wednesday** in Miss Capron-Tee's classroom from September. Children are expected to attend **every** week from September until concert day in January. There is **lots** of music and dances to learn. We have fun, but we work hard!

What happens on the concert day?

The morning is in school as normal. We go by coach to the NEC, rehearse all afternoon, then have the concert in the evening. We get back to school to be picked up from the school car park around 9.45pm.

Can I go to the concert?

Yes! Tickets will be available to buy for the concert. Details will be sent out to club members.

Can I buy a Young Voices t-shirt?

Children don't need a Young Voices t-shirt, but if you want one, details will be sent out to the club.

Is it right for my child?

It is a truly fantastic experience – ask anyone who went last year! But it is also a lot of work.

Children **MAY NOT** drop out of the club. Do not apply for a place if you and your child are not prepared to commit to it. Attendance is expected every week in club. The arena is very big and the rehearsals and concert are very loud – we tend to be pretty loud in the club each week as well. If your child is anxious about loud noises and/or crowds, Young Voices is probably not for them.
