Dear Parents & Carers

This term Year 2 have been finding out about what life was like for Victorian children who worked in the mines.

To support this, we are going to visit the Black Country Living Museum on **Friday 8 April**. The children will visit the Victorian town, experience a lesson in the Victorian classroom, look around the colliery and take part in the Mining Madness Science workshop. We **won't** be going underground in the mine.

We will need to leave school promptly at **9.00am** so the children can come into school on that day from 8.30pm. We aim to be back at school for 3.00pm.

Most of the museum is outdoors. It would be preferable for everyone to wear trousers with their school jumper or cardigan. The PE joggers and hoody would be great. Everyone needs a coat.

All children need:

- a packed lunch in a named carrier bag
- a warm coat/waterproof jacket.
- suitable shoes for walking outdoors.



Children in Year 2 are entitled to Universal or Free School meals. Please be aware the slip needs to be returned by no later than **Tuesday 5 April**.
