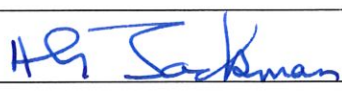

PE Kit Policy

We have launched a new PE kit policy to take effect immediately.

This has been done to ensure that the whole school follows the correct procedures and all children have their correct kit for PE lessons.

School PE Kit

School PE kit is:

- a white t-shirt
- black shorts/jogging bottoms.
- Black pumps/trainers

For children in Nursery only, parents can bring shorts for their child to wear during PE lessons if they wish. If not, then children will participate in PE wearing their underwear and school t-shirt.

For Year 1 to Year 4 pupils we stock an outside PE kit which consists of a yellow sweatshirt and jogging bottoms, both with the Woodrow logo, that can be purchased from the school office. Plain black jogging bottoms are acceptable.

This is suggested, but not enforced.

Clubs

If children have an after school club, then they are expected to wear the same PE kit as stated above.

Forgetting kit

On the first occasion that a child forgets their kit they will be provided with a PE kit from school. The school has 8 spare kits per year group. These are kept in the school hall.

If kit is forgotten a second time the child will be provided with a kit from school and a polite reminder letter will be sent to parents and carers (Appendix A). The letter will also explain that if this continues a meeting will be requested with Mr Kieran to discuss why the PE kit is not in school.

If the child forgets their kit for a third time they will still be provided with a kit from school, but a meeting will be arranged with Mr Kieran to discuss the matter further.

As always, we endeavour to support our parents and carers to ensure every child has their entitlement to at least 2 hours of Physical Education per week.

Not taking part in PE

If a child cannot take part in PE or swimming for any reason a letter must be provided by the parent or carer; unless the child has a serious illness/injury they will be expected to take part.

If the child is well enough to be in school, then we deem them well enough to participate in PE and swimming lessons.

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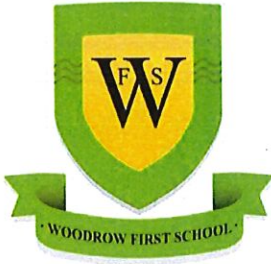
