REMEMBER: If your son/daughter attends our Nursery you will still need to apply for a September Reception place!



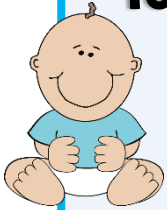

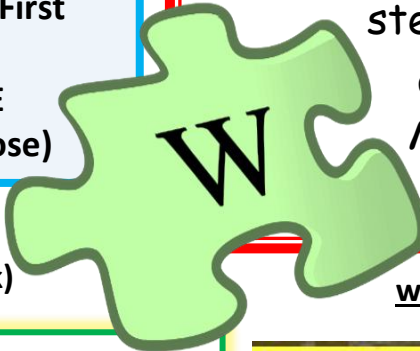
In The Studio, Woodrow First School

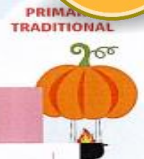
