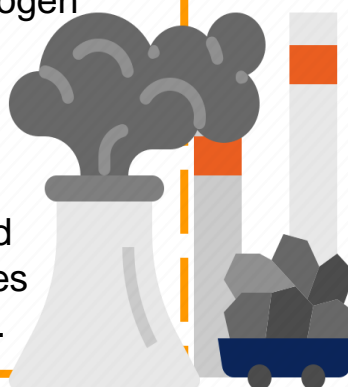


## Tyseley Energy Park
