Have a fantastic Easter break. Don't eat too many eggs and we will see you all after the holidays.

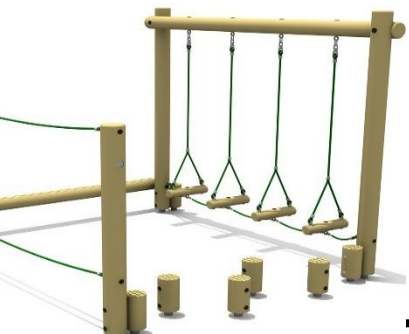
We hope the children enjoy their Easter lollies.
