It is getting cramped!

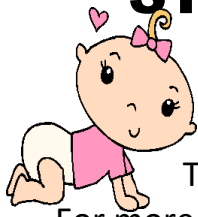


Farewell and Good Luck

Cycling on the Playground

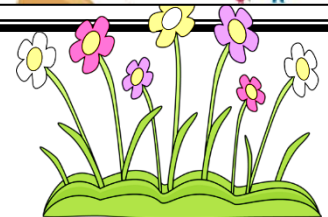
In the mornings and at the end of the day we ask that children do not cycle around school.
